Saturday & Sunday Schedule: 8:45 AM: Driver's meeting at the golf course clubhouse. 9:30 AM: 8 Dog Class. 10:30 AM: 4 Dog Sled, 3 Dog Junior and 1 Dog Skijor Classes. Dual starts. No pause between classes. 11:30 AM: 6 Dog Sled and 2 Dog Skijor Classes. Dual starts. No pause between classes. 1:30 PM (SATURDAY ONLY): Shelter Dog Shuffle! 1 mile loop, mass start. Prizes for fastest shelter dogs.

Important information:

- No phone entries – Entries close at noon Wednesday March 3rd, 2010. Entries received after this time will be placed at the end of the start order as they are received. Absolutely no entries will be accepted later than one half hour before the Saturday morning drivers meeting.
- Dog marking of all Sanctioned Classes will be at the finish line of each class on Saturday.
- Purebred numbers (American Kennel Club or Canadian Kennel Club) must be submitted with the entry form, entry w/o papers will be drawn in the mixed breed class
- 1 dog skijor will be run on the 4-mile trail and the 2 dog skijor will be run on the 6-mile trail.
- Scheduling of the events will prevent a single driver from racing in the 1 dog skijor and 4 dog sled or the 2 dog skijor and 6 dog sled classes. Do not enter both skijor and sled classes of the same distance.
- Mount Massive Golf Course will be selling food at the club house.

Race Options and Information:

ISDRA seeding will be used to determine starting order for Saturday in all sanctioned classes. NO WHIPS ALLOWED – A snow hook and regulation dog bag (ventilated) are mandatory in all sled classes. All race participants under age 18 will be required to wear an appropriate safety helmet. The RMSDC recommends that the helmet be DOT, ANSI, or Snell certified. Race Officials may handle dogs at any time. Parking by class in designated areas is required by the Race Giving Organization. All teams must be in the staging area 2 minutes prior to the start in all classes.

The Rocky Mountain Sled Dog Club, Inc. will not be held responsible for errors in seeding caused by the use of ISDRA's Raceworks program. This program, it's seeding and membership updates are controlled entirely by ISDRA and neither RMSDC, Inc. nor its Race Secretary have any control over its seeding and draw functions. If you have questions about the seeding for this race, contact ISDRA.

No entry fees will be refunded unless the race is cancelled.

I acknowledge that there are risks of injury to persons or possible damage to equipment while participating in a sled dog race. I further acknowledge that I am participating in this race at my own risk. I understand that The Rocky Mountain Sled Dog Club, Inc. and ISDRA are corporations formed to advance the sport of sled dog racing, and that their efforts directly benefit me.

In consideration of my being permitted to participate in this race, on behalf of myself, my heirs, assigns and personal representatives, I hereby waive, release and forever discharge The Rocky Mountain Sled Dog Club, Inc., ISDRA any organizations or individuals involved in organizing and/or sponsoring this race, any municipalities or other public entities, and all of their employees, agents, officers, directors, attorneys, members, sponsors, promoters and affiliates whosoever from any and all liability, claim, loss, cost or expense for personal injury, death or property damage arising from or attributable in any way to any action or omission to act of any such person or organization in the sanctioning, organizing or execution of this sled dog event, or my participation therein, even though that liability may arise out of negligence or carelessness on the part of the persons or entities mentioned above, including but not limited to travel to or from or parking at the sled dog event.

Knowing the above risks of sled dog racing, I nevertheless hereby agree to assume those risks and to release, discharge and hold harmless all of the persons or entities mentioned above who (through negligence, carelessness or otherwise) might be liable to me or my heirs or assigns, for any and all damages for death, personal injury or property damage of any kind. The risks which I assume are all of those involved in participation in a sled dog event, including, but not limited to, those relating to trail conditions, weather conditions, passing of teams, contact between dogs and mushers on different teams or the same team, starting and finishing the race, sanctioning and officiating the race, spectator presence at the race, announcing and timing of the race, travel to and from and parking at the race, and all other natural and manmade conditions of any kind whatsoever pertaining to or occurring at this event.
